Riverfield has committed to the provision of recycled water via third or "purple pipe". All homes constructed must be connected to the South East Water Reticulated Recycled Water System as specified by the relevant authorities, for the provision of toilet flushing and garden irrigation.

OPTICOMM FIBRE TO THE PREMISES (FTTP) NETWORK

Riverfield allows access to the OptiComm network for the provision of high speed broadband and telephone services. To gain access, all homes must comply with the OptiComm requirements. Installation of any wiring in the dwelling for the purposes of connection to the OptiComm Network (if available to the Development) must comply with the OptiComm Cable Entry Guide for an Internal ONT. The lot owner or the lot owner's builder must procure a copy of that installation guide (as may be amended from time to time) from the OptiComm Co Pty Ltd website. Failure to comply with the in home wiring requirements could result in the lot owner being prevented from connection to the OptiComm Network or being charged fees by the service provider/installer.
