

Wow, so much has happened it's hard to know where to start! Stages 21, 22, 23, 24 and 25 are all officially titled, with our first residents moving into their new homes in July and many more preparing to join our growing community. The excitement is

There's been plenty of progress across Riverfield as we move into winter, with several stages well on their way to completion.

Stage 25 is now officially titled within Riverfield Rise, marking an exciting milestone for future residents. We're excited to see this premium precinct take shape.

Stage 29 is nearly there, with footpaths, asphalt and topsoil works currently underway and on track for completion by the end of June.

In Stage 30, July will be a big month, with kerbs being installed early on, followed by the delivery of electrical and telecommunications services around midmonth, and asphalt works shortly after.

Similarly, Stage 31 will see kerb installation begin mid-July, with roadworks picking up

pace soon after.

Sewer and drainage works in Stage 26 are set to wrap up this month, with watermains to follow. Meanwhile, in Stage 27, sewer works are nearing completion and will be followed by drainage installation and road preparation

We're excited to see the community continue to take shape and look forward to sharing more progress with you soon.

WINTER COMFORT

One Pot Italian Chicken

This simple recipe will warm the soul on even the chilliest winter day.



Ingredients:

- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 20g unsalted butter
- · 4 small chicken breast fillets
- · 2 cloves finely chopped garlic
- · 80g sliced sun-dried tomatoes
- · 80ml white wine
- · 250ml thickened cream
- · 125ml chicken stock
- 60g pkt baby spinach
- 1 cup torn basil leaves
- · Crusty bread to serve

Method:

- 1. Heat the oil and butter in a large frying pan until butter foams. Season the chicken and add to the pan, reducing heat to medium-high. Cook for 5 mins each side. Transfer to a plate and cover with foil.
- 2. Add garlic to the pan. Cook, stirring, for 1 minute. Add tomatoes & wine and cook 1 minute to reduce. Add cream & stock and stir
- 3. Return chicken to the pan and simmer for 5 minutes or until liquid is reduced. Stir through spinach to wilt. Season & sprinkle with basil. Serve with crusty bread.
